

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – 22 APRIL 2020

Sandblasting Works in Entry Garden as part of Heritage Interpretation – Tuesday, 28th April

We will be undertaking essential sandblasting works associated with the heritage interpretation works next Tuesday, 28th April on the concrete wall near the Entry Garden lift.

Access to the IBC building and the lift will be maintained at all times. The work zone will clearly be delineated using AFT fencing and signage.

What to expect

These works are typically noisy as the sandblasting involves the use of a compressor. This is likely to cause some disruption, especially to nearby tenants at the IBC and NIC Buildings. The noisy works are expected to take place for approximately three hours in the morning.

Work duration

Workers are expected to arrive on site at 7:30am and commence setting up which is anticipated to take an hour. Following that, sandblasting is expected to take approximately three hours to complete, however progress could be delayed due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather. Works are expected to finish at 5:00pm.
